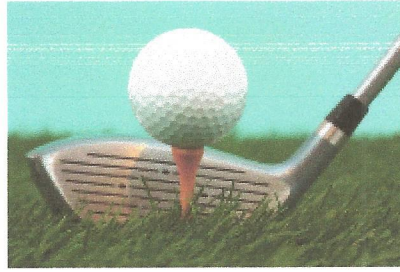




LIVING IN RECOVERY

We hope to see you all next year for the 4th Annual Living in Recovery Golf Tournament.

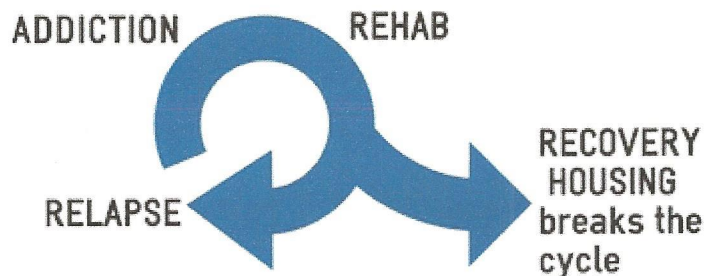
